Recognizing a Need and Building a Framework

Indigo made employee and contractor safety a critical priority, establishing a safety culture built on the company’s guiding principle, “Nobody Gets Hurt Today.”

A web-based HSE data management system was launched for employees to report incidents in real time as well as enter safety observations and improvement opportunities.

Executing Commitments

Indigo achieved two years without a Lost Time Incident (December 2019). More than 10,000 work observations and over 4,800 corrective actions have been recorded.

Achieving Carbon Neutral Status

Indigo has begun a comprehensive review of its greenhouse gas sources and emissions to identify opportunities for emissions reductions. Indigo not only leverages carbon offset purchases to support their carbon neutral goals, but is also actively implementing new technologies and working practices to reduce emissions. These include use of piped water instead of trucked water, use of green completion techniques that return vent gases to their underground source, and use of emissions control technologies to capture and process emissions streams instead of venting to the environment.
